### Candidates for Town Council must be:

- ⇒ 21 years of age,
- ⇒ a citizen of the United States, and
- ⇒ a registered voter of Cheverly,
- ⇒ a resident of Cheverly for not less than 6 months, and
- ⇒ a resident of the ward from which they are elected (at least 45 days before the date of the election).

**FILING INSTRUCTIONS:** Filing forms may be obtained at the Town Office during normal business hours (Monday-Friday, 9AM-5PM) Call 301-773-8360. Completed forms must be returned to the Town Office **no later than 5:00PM, Friday, March 18, 2005.**

**NOTE: Pictures & Profiles of Candidates** are run in the April Newsletter. They must be submitted with the nominating petition or by the filing deadline (**March 18**).

- ⇒ **Candidate Profiles must be brief (no longer than 350 words).** Profiles will appear as written. They will not be edited or corrected;

### **ABSENTEE VOTING:**

To vote by absentee ballot in the Cheverly Municipal Election a qualified voter must file an *Application for an Absentee Ballot* with the Board of Election Supervisors, 6401 Forest Road, Cheverly, **not later than 7 days before election (April 25, 2005)**. Applications are available at the Town Office or from our website at [www.cheverly.com](http://www.cheverly.com).

The following persons may vote in the Town of Cheverly elections by absentee ballot:

- a. Any qualified voter who will be absent from Cheverly during the entire period the polls are open on election day:
- b. Any qualified voter whose physical disability prevents or will prevent the voter from being present and voting at the polls on election day.



### **MULCH**

The Public Works Department has contracted with Maryland Environmental Services (MES) again this year to grind our leaves, yard waste, brush and Xmas trees into a fine grade mulch. Public Works will begin deliveries near the end of March. **Schedule a delivery now.**

**Public Works keeps a large mound of the mulch at the town park parking lot near the ballfields for residents to help themselves.** The Town DOES NOT provide wood chip mulch for residents. Any mounds of wood chips in the parks IS FOR THE PARKS and is not available for residents to take.

**Contact the PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE to schedule a mulch delivery.** They are open Monday-Friday from **7:30AM to 4:00PM**.

You need to fill out a delivery request form, pay the fee, and set up a delivery date.



**NOTE: The Maximum for one delivery is two (2) scoops of the bulldozer. The fee is \$20 per delivery.**

If you have any questions you can call **301-773-2666**.

Public Works can only deliver mulch where there is a driveway or a safe place to back their dump truck and tip the load on the lawn.

**REMINDER:** If you leave mulch on the lawn for very long—it will kill the grass underneath.

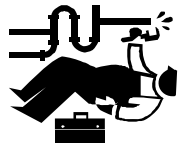
