### **CICADA CRUNCH II - 5K Run & 2K Fun Walk - DASH FOR DIABETES!**



You, your family, and friends can help keep the memory of Cicada Brood X alive and raise funds to help prevent and find a cure for diabetes by participating in Cheverly Day's second annual Cicada Crunch 5K Run & 2K Fun Walk!

The Cicada Crunch II--Dash for Diabetes will

take place on **Saturday, June 11<sup>th</sup>** starting at **10:00AM** at Cheverly Town Park. You can run or walk the rolling hills of Cheverly and then join us for a day of games, rides, music, food, rock climbing, and fireworks at Cheverly Day.

Last year, 250 people ran or walked among the cicadas and raised \$2,500 for breast cancer research and programs. This year, we hope to have at least as many participants and the proceeds will benefit diabetes research, information, and advocacy programs through a donation to the *American Diabetes Association*. (Charities and causes for the Cicada Crunch are chosen annually and represent issues of concern to the Cheverly community.)

Diabetes can affect all ages. More than 18.2 million people in the U.S. have diabetes and another 41 million people have pre-diabetes. The exact cause of diabetes isn't known. However, genetics and environmental problems, such as obesity and lack of exercise, appear to play a role. On-line and mail registrations must be completed and sent before June 1. After June 1, you can only register on race day between 8:45 and 9:45AM at the Cheverly Community Center. Mailed forms and checks, payable to the *Cheverly Day Committee*, should be sent to: Cheverly Day 5K Run, c/o Cheverly Day Committee, 6401 Forest Road, Cheverly, MD 20785.

Early bird registration fees (on or before June 1) are \$20 for the 5K run/walk and \$12 for the 2K fun walk. Race day registration fees are \$25 for the 5K run/walk and \$15 for the fun walk.

All race participants will receive a Cheverly Day Cicada Crunch II t-shirt. Awards will be given to the top three male and female finishers overall, the top male and female masters (40+), and top three males and females in each ten year age group from 19 and under to 60+.



### Friends of Lower Beaverdam Creek Seeks Recruits

Friends of Lower Beaverdam Creek has had a busy spring. On March 26, more than 80 people helped pull invasive plants out of Woodworth Park. On April 16 about a dozen folks pulled 113 old tires – many of them large truck tires -- out of the beaver ponds and hauled them up to Rt. 50, where a State Highway Administration truck picked them up and hauled them off to be recycled. (This saved the town a considerable amount of money.) Volunteers also planted more than 30 trees on that day, which were procured free from the County. We continue to work on the trail on the last Saturday of every month and will have an official trail opening on Cheverly Day. ## NATIONAL HEALTH SURVEY NOW IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY

There's a big health survey coming to town and you may be invited. The National Health and Nutrition Examination Survey (NHANES) conducted by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) will be in your community starting on April 15 through June 11, 2005. Prince George's county residents will have the opportunity to participate in the nation's most comprehensive study that monitors the health and nutrition of the U.S. population.

Participants randomly selected to participate receive a detailed interview, a physical examination which can include a bone density scan, a hearing exam, a vision test, and basic body measurements such as height, and weight. In addition, we conduct a dietary interview, provide an oral health exam and take your blood pressure. The various tests and procedures depend upon the age and gender of the participant. This is a chance to have important tests done and gain additional information about your health.

## MULCH

The Public Works Department has contracted with Maryland Environmental Services (MES) again this year to grind our leaves, yard waste, brush and Xmas trees into a fine grade mulch. Public Works began deliveries near the end of March.

**Contact the PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE to schedule a mulch delivery.** They are open Monday-Friday from **7:30AM to 4:00PM.**

**NOTE: The Maximum for one delivery is two (2) scoops of the bulldozer. The fee is \$20 per delivery.** If you have any questions you can call **301-773-2666.**



Public Works can only deliver mulch where there is a driveway or a safe place to back their dump truck and tip the load on the lawn. **REMINDER: If you leave mulch on the lawn for very long—it will kill the grass underneath.**

**The Town DOES NOT provide wood chip mulch for residents. Any mounds of wood chips in the parks IS FOR THE PARKS and is not available for residents to take.**
