MUNICIPAL CODE VIOLATIONS

Animal Violations

4.3 Public Nuisance – Fierce, vicious, or unlicensed animal or 3rd violation within 1 year for;

- a. At-large
- b. Damaging public/private property
- c. Excessive noise or barking

Penalty – \$100 or 30 days jail

4.4 Unsecured Animal

4.6 Cruelty to animal or bird

4.10 Failure to remove solid waste

Penalty - \$25 1st Offense;

2nd Offense within 2 years \$50

Tree Preservation

6.7 Damaging tree in public place

Penalty - \$50 Fine

Soliciting (Door to door)

Soliciting without a license

Penalty - \$100

Littering

10-1 (1) Littering on public/private property

10-1 (2) Littering on roadway

10-1 (3) Oil or other dangerous substance on street or other public space, gutter, ditch, etc.

10-2 Litter or rubbish from vehicle

10-3 Piling debris on roadway

Penalty - \$25 Fine

Outdoor Burning

12-3 (b) Burning trash, lumber, leaves, etc. w/o permit

Penalty - \$50 Fine

Antivandalism

15-9 Applying graffiti, public/private

Penalty - \$50 Fine

Abandoned Vehicle

18-4.2 Abandoning vehicle on public area for 48 Hrs

Private property more than 30 days

Penalty – Impoundment and/or \$400 Fine

Public Nuisance

18-5 Public nuisance

- (a) Grass higher than 8”
- (b) Accumulated trees/limbs on ground
- (d) Accumulated debris
- (e) Fences in disrepair

Penalty - \$50 Fine

18-6 (e) Abandoned machinery – danger to public

(f) Unprotected excavations (Call Fire Dept)

(g) Discarded furniture/appliances visible from street

Penalty - \$400 Fine

Noise Violations

19-4(b) Continuous audible noise (radio, tape, CD, etc.) from 30 ft of residence day or night

19-7 (b) Radios, phonographs heard in park, public area within 30 ft

(c) Loud cutoff mufflers

(d) Between 2300 and 0800 Hrs, any source that disturbs peace and quiet of neighborhood

(e) S/A, except mechanical tools before 0900 Hrs on Sunday

Penalty – Verbal warning first; 2nd complaint within 7 days \$50; 2nd and subsequent \$200

BB or Pellet Guns

20-3 Discharge of weapon

Penalty \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Games of Chance

20-20 Set-up or operate game of chance

Penalty - \$25 Fine

Consuming Alcohol on Public Property

20-15 Parks (W/O permit), streets or other public property

Penalty - \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Fireworks

20-2 Exploding or setting off fireworks

Penalty \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Tampering With Public Property

20-8 Tamper, break, damage any light, sign, or official marker of Town or public utility

Penalty - \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Trespass

20-13(a) Fail to leave Town building or public area during closed hours

20-13(b) Failure to leave same, being disruptive

Penalty - \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Begging or Soliciting Money or Favor

20-17 Begging or soliciting in any area open to the public

Penalty - \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Disorderly House

Maintaining premise allowing people to congregate for alcohol, profane language, fighting, or disturbing the peace.

Penalty - \$25 Fine

2nd violation W/I 2 years; \$400 or 30 days jail

Sign, Public Right-of-Ways

23-2 Prohibits posting any sign on public right-of-way

Penalty - \$50, \$100 each repeat offense

Parking Violations – All Violations \$50

27-3 Parking, Failure to obey official sign or traffic control device

27-5 Parking, General

- (a) 15ft of a hydrant, 25 ft intersection curb lines
- (b) Park of sidewalk or block driveway
- (c) More than 72 hours
- (d) Park on an public park land outside lot
- (e) Commercial vehicle between 1900 and 0700 in residential area
- (f) Unlicensed or disabled veh, public property
- (g) Park on land of another
- (h) Follow fire truck W/I 500 ft
- (i) Cross over unprotected fire hose
- (j) Town buildings, park in space
- (k) In alley blocking other vehicles
- (l) Perform any vehicle maintenance other than minor on any public street
- (m) Park on Cheverly Ave, Lydell Rd, Pepsi or Schuster – Must right wheels to curb

27-5.1 Violation, residential permit park areas, for Over 3 hr period 0700 – 2200

27-5.2 Violation of Public Parking Facility (METRO) regs/signs

27.5.3 Off-Street Parking and Storage

(c)(2)(b) At any time, stake platform trucks, dump trucks, crane or tow trucks, any dual wheel vehicle

(d)(1) Unlicensed or disabled vehicle

(e) Parking on unpaved area, residential lot

27-8 Park W/O required MD registration plates as required in TA 13-402.1

Fire Lane

County Code 11-277c

Penalty - \$200 Fine

Handicap – No Stand or Park

County Code 26-127.03b

Penalty \$200 Fine
