Cheverly Targeted Inspection Initiative

How to Provide Information to MDE

MDE's Air and Radiation Administration (ARA) is working in partnership with the Town of Cheverly and the University of Maryland's Center for Community Engagement, Environmental Justice, and Health (CEEJH) to implement a local air monitoring program in the Cheverly area using low-cost sensors to look at community scale air quality. Over the next few months, as part of this partnership, ARA is undertaking an enhanced and targeted inspection campaign at permitted emission sources and general observations at other sources, such as locations where diesel trucks or buses idle for long periods. Overall, emissions from these sources have the potential to influence air quality in the Cheverly area. Input from the public with respect to the operation of these sources or their emissions is welcome. There are a number of ways to provide your input.
