COME HELP THE TOWN PLAN FOR FUTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO CHEVERLY TOWN PARK

Back in 2013, the Town prepared a Cheverly Town Park Master Plan that identified improvements needed in the park. Our planning efforts recently received a boost. The Low Impact Development Center (LID Center), which is a non-profit based in Beltsville, MD, received grant funding from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation to conduct preliminary engineering investigations to better locate desired site improvements and stormwater management opportunities and bring the area up to 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design. The Town intends to use this information to seek additional grant opportunities for final design and construction funds.

The project was kicked off in February at a meeting with the Town's Green Infrastructure Committee and will end in September.
