

THE TOWN OF CHEVERLY'S TRASH SCHEDULE FOR MEMORIAL DAY WEEK

5/25/2020 TO 5/29/2020



MEMORIAL DAY, MONDAY MAY 25, 2020, THERE WILL BE **NO** TRASH COLLECTION.

West Side Trash will be collected on its usual day of **Tuesday**, May 26, 2020.

Town-Wide Yard Waste will also be picked up on **Tuesday**, May 26.

Recycling collection will continue as regularly scheduled on **Wednesday**, May 27, 2020.

East Side Trash will be picked up on **Thursday**, May 28, 2020.

Special Town-Wide Bulk Trash and Appliance Pick-up!
Households will be limited to no more than three (3) items.

Bulk Trash examples are old furniture such as a couch, chair, bed, rug, lamp, and table. Each item counts as 1 item. A mattress, bedspring, and headboard count as one item. Public Works cannot pick up more than 3 items of bulk trash. Additional items will need to be left behind and residents will be responsible for pulling remaining items back from the curb for storage.

Appliances will be picked up and must be scheduled. A charge of \$20 for one + \$10 for each additional appliance will be sent to your home after pick-up. Examples include a refrigerator, air conditioner, dryer, washer, and dishwasher. Please note a washer and dryer count as two items. We must limit households to no more than three (3) appliances.

Please call 301-773-2666 if you have any questions about what is and what is not allowed. No hazardous materials (such as batteries) will be picked up.

Please remember that there is a limit of 3 items for both bulk trash and appliance pick-up.

The Town of Cheverly thanks you for your understanding during these trying times.

As you know, the Department of Public Works has been focusing on trying to maintain the essential service of sanitation collection and protecting the employees who provide this service.

Although we want things to return to normal as soon as you do, we cannot safely do so at this time. Thank you for your continued patience. The Public Works employees appreciate all the support that residents have shown over the past several weeks. We will do our best to include some more bulk trash pick-ups, as well as fill in some potholes, as we continue to focus on maintaining sanitation collection while we look to re-open safely for our residents and valued employees.

The Town is grateful for the professionalism and commitment of all of our Town employees including the Department of Public Works, our Police Department and our Administrative employees, who have continued to work throughout this crisis.

We will return to our PW COVID-19 (Monday – Wednesday) pick-up schedule on 6/1/2020.

Please note that the following services continue to be temporarily suspended.

Until further notice: bulk trash pick-up, appliance pick-up, mulch delivery, tree planting, recycling bin sales, rain barrel sales, compost bin sales, payments for past services, and all other non-essential services provided by Public Works are not being fulfilled at this time.

As a reminder, all Town buildings, Town playgrounds, courts and fields remain closed to the public. Parks and trails remain open for users who continue to responsibly maintain a distance of six feet from others sharing the trails.

Please be safe, well, and continue to maintain proper distancing in your activities.

Our individual and collective actions will determine the course of COVID-19 in our community. Here in Cheverly, community has shown that we can both keep physically distanced and stay socially connected. Distancing keeps us safe and connecting keeps us well.
