The Position

The Town of Cheverly, Maryland is seeking qualified candidates for the position of **Chief of Police.**

The position of Cheverly Chief of Police offers an opportunity to plan and direct the activities of the police department and enforce laws using community-oriented policing. The successful candidate will have a proven record of collaborative and inclusive leadership, innovation, community engagement, and improved public safety. The candidate must also possess the ability to build relationships, trust, and respect in the community; among officers, employees, and fellow staff leaders; as well as with the Mayor and Council. The candidate must have a demonstrated ability to formulate law enforcement strategies around emerging trends as well as an understanding of the continuously evolving technologies to assist in these law enforcement initiatives.

The Chief of Police will possess a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, law enforcement, public or business administration or related field, and at least ten (10) years of progressively responsible full-time law enforcement work. A graduate degree is desirable. Experience in a supervisory/administrative capacity is required.

The Cheverly Police Department has 16 sworn and 3 civilian positions, and a FY 2022 Budget of just over \$2.3M.

The Town will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by a respondent in preparing, submitting, or presenting an application packet.

INTRODUCTION TO THE TOWN

The Town of Cheverly, Maryland, is a welcoming community of 6,400 residents in a 1.2 square mile area. The community is located near Washington, D.C. in Prince George's County at the intersection of the Baltimore-Washington Parkway, MD50, and MD202. The Cheverly METRO station provides a quick link to Washington and other parts of the region.

Cheverly is a diverse community. The community regards its diversity as a core strength and is dedicated to increasing access and inclusion. The Cheverly Police Department's role is to assist in maintaining a safe community while reflecting these values, and in a manner that engages community, builds trust and reflects the best of community-oriented policing practices. Out of recognition that police acting as an arm of federal immigration-related agencies can run counter to the goals of community safety and trust in policing, the Town enacted an ordinance in 2018 to prohibit the department from inquiring about the immigration status of individuals with whom officers come into contact.
